Pathways to Discipleship

Pathways to Discipleship

Many Australians have a sense of spirituality or faith, but they don't know or care about the church. How might a community of faith create awareness, build relationships, invite inquiry, foster commitment and grow disciples?

"Pathways" is a simple process to help churches map possible pathways to Christian faith and discipleship and identify gaps in these pathways in their community life. The process allows churches to shape their own choices for the future.

The Pathways process can be completed by a congregational leadership team in a couple of hours and leads to actions that will help build discipleship pathways. This workshop trains leaders to lead the process in their home situation.

"Pathways" was developed by Church Ministry Resources in Victoria and has been used by the Synod of Queensland in developing local mission.

You are invited to come as a team from your church and will work together as a group during the evening.

Craig Mitchell is a Lecturer at Uniting College and has worked with city and rural churches in education, leadership and mission. He has completed a train-the-trainer program in "Pathways".
